Signing a memorandum of understanding between the Egyptian Air Holding Company and Sudan Airways



In order to strengthen Egyptian relations with the State of Sudan, his excellency Pilot. Mohamed Manar, Minister of Civil Aviation, witnessed the signing of a memorandum of understanding between EGYPTAIR Holding Company and Sudan Airways, in presence of Mr. Khaled Al Sheikh, Sudanese Deputy Ambassador to the Arab Republic of Egypt.

The memorandum was signed by Mr. Yasser Timo, Director General of Sudan Airways, and Pilot. Amr Abuelenein, EGYPTAIR Holding Chairman.

At the beginning of the meeting, Minister of Aviation welcomed Mr. Yasser Timo, praising the strategic partnership between EGYPTAIR and Sudan Airways to enhance opportunities for trade exchange and activate Aviation within the Egyptian government plan to support bilateral relations between the

two countries to seize All possibilities and for the transfer of Egyptian expertise to the Sudanese side, especially in the field of civil aviation.

Pilot. Manar added that the MOU includes the Egyptian aviation cadres training Sudanese Airliner's personnel in the fields of aircraft piloting and inflight cabin crew training, as well as participating in modernizing the Sudan Airways fleet of aircraft, managing networks planning, developing maintenance and overhauling activities for Sudanese airliner and providing all advisory services in the fields of quality. Technical accreditations, including ISO and TSO certification, in addition to developing services provided in the field of duty-free and inflight services, training Sudanese Airliner's personnel in the field of aviation security, as well as developing ground services, providing equipment, qualification to obtain ISO certification, cooperation in the field of Cargo, and discussing other future cooperation aspects in order to keep pace with the increase in traffic volume, in a way that contributes to increasing the economic growth rates of the two national companies..

Both parties agreed to form a joint working group and hold periodic meetings to follow up intended projects and contracts implemented in the areas of cooperation agreed upon.

On his part, Mr. Yasser Timo, Director General of Sudan Airways, expressed his happiness at signing the memorandum of understanding with EGYPTAIR, due to its expertise, human cadres and great technical capabilities, praising the long history of EGYPTAIR as the first airline established in the Middle East and Africa.
